

Coming in September, 2008 - Lost & Found by Tom Williams

The story centers around two English expatriates who are hired by a major oil company to find oil reserves *anywhere* in the world using a geological survey satellite. Under threats from the company's corrupt president to find oil, and believing the satellite does not work as designed, the men decide to reconfigure the orbiting spacecraft to search for gold. Spied on by the company's head of security, they are quickly fired and removed from the premises. After a helpful female co-worker downloads the new satellite information containing underwater GPS coordinates for gold she later turns up murdered. Blackmailed by the company president, and threatened with murder charges and sabotage to the satellite, the Englishmen have thirty days to prove that the gold found from the spacecraft is real; they aren't responsible for a falling satellite and the brutal murder of a former girlfriend.

Followed by the head of security, the men head to Florida where they meet up with a sultry and beautiful salvage captain who then travels with them to a remote section on the Turkish coast to search for sunken treasure. This non-stop action story is full of twists and turns with a cast of characters that includes the head of security, the local gang leader in Turkey, the oil company's CEO and shareholders back in Texas - all hot on the trail of the three in search of gold. In the exciting race for the treasure, the cast of characters battle a treacherous storm, an earthquake, a tsunami, and each other.
